Clause 1 – Agreement to Perform Services

Mechanic agrees to perform the Services in a professional manner consistent with industry standards. Client agrees to provide necessary access and information for completion of Services.

Clause 2 – Authorization and Consent

Client authorizes Mechanic to perform the Services described herein and any additional services approved by Client prior to performance.

Clause 3 – Condition and Acceptance

Services and any parts supplied are provided AS-IS, with no warranties except as expressly provided herein or by law. Client acknowledges opportunity to inspect Services upon completion.

Clause 4 – Payment and Fees

Client shall pay Mechanic the agreed Total Service Price in accordance with the Payment Method and Schedule specified above. Late payments may incur interest as allowed by law.

Clause 5 – Parts and Materials

Mechanic may use new, used, or reconditioned parts as agreed with Client. Ownership of replaced parts will transfer to Mechanic unless otherwise agreed.

Clause 6 – Completion Timeline

Mechanic will use reasonable efforts to complete Services within the Estimated Completion Time but shall not be liable for delays beyond its control.

Clause 7 – Liability and Indemnification

Mechanic is not liable for damages resulting from pre-existing conditions or misuse by Client. Client shall indemnify and hold Mechanic harmless from claims arising out of Client’s negligence or misrepresentations.

Clause 8 – Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement by written notice if the other party materially breaches any term and fails to cure within a reasonable period.

Clause 9 – Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of _____ without regard to conflict-of-law principles. The parties consent to exclusive jurisdiction and venue in the state or federal courts located in _____ County, _____.

Clause 10 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether oral or written.

Clause 11 – Amendments

Any modifications or amendments must be in writing signed by both parties to be effective.

Clause 12 – Severability

If any provision is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Clause 13 – Notices

All notices must be in writing and delivered personally, by certified mail, overnight courier, or electronic means capable of confirming delivery.

Clause 14 – Confidentiality

Parties agree to keep confidential all non-public information learned in connection with this Agreement, except as required by law.

Clause 15 – Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of that provision or any other rights under this Agreement.

Clause 16 – Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for delays or failures due to causes beyond reasonable control, including natural disasters, strikes, or governmental actions.

Clause 17 – Independent Contractor

Mechanic is an independent contractor and not an employee, partner, or agent of Client.

Clause 18 – Insurance

Mechanic maintains appropriate insurance coverage for liability and workers' compensation as required by law.

Clause 19 – Dispute Resolution

Parties agree to attempt negotiation in good faith prior to pursuing legal remedies.

Clause 20 – Signatures

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which is deemed an original and all of which constitute one agreement.
